*The mojito is one of Cuba's oldest cocktails. Famous author Ernest Hemingway favored them. Mojito comes from the African word MOJO, which means to place a little spell. Depending on how many you drink, it could be a big, big spell. Happy sipping!*

- 4 mint leaves
- 1 t. confectioner's sugar
- Juice of one fresh lime
- 2 ounces white rum
- 2 ounces club soda

*Combine the first 3 ingredients in a tall glass. Use the back of a spoon or a muddler and crush the mint leaves. Add rum and club soda, pour over ice. You can strain the mint leaves if you wish. I think it's more fun to leave the leaves in your drink A. because it's pretty and B. if you really do have good friends, they will tell you, you have mint leaves sticking to your teeth!
