THREE DAY BRISKET

DAY 1

4-5 lb. brisket
1 small bottle liquid smoke
1 tsp. seasoning salt
1 tsp. garlic powder

sprinkle with Adolph's meat tenderizer wrap in foil and refrigerate overnight.

DAY 2

Drain, rewrap in foil Bake 300 degrees for 5 hours.

cool down and refrigerate overnight.

Day 3

Slice thin, pour BBQ sauce over top, rewrap and bake @300 degrees for 1 hour.

BBQ Sauce

3 T brown sugar
1 C. ketchup
2 tsp. celery salt
6 tsp. melted butter
4 T worcestershire
3 tsp. dry mustard
dash of pepper
