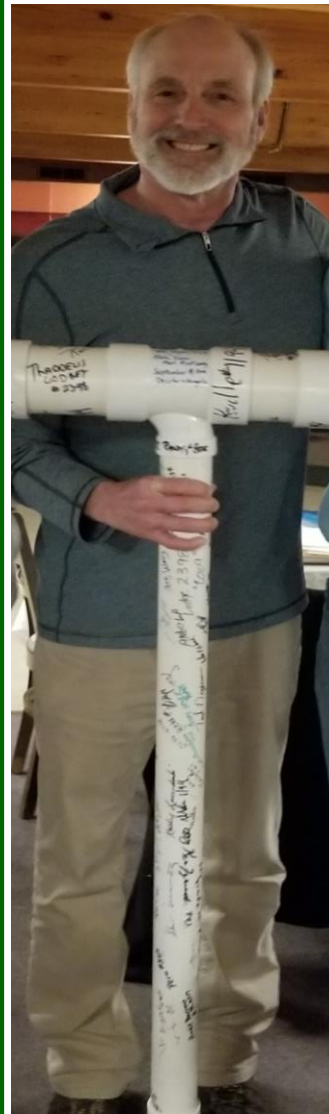

History lesson #5!

On Saturday June 17, 1916, The News Sentinel announced that the Rochester Golf Club would open its links the next Friday. That would have been June 23! (I checked the date three times to make sure this was correct!)

On June 23, 1916 seventy five Members, their wives, and guests opened the course with a Tournament. It was quite an event. There were card games provided on the bank for "the women who did not take part on the links" a six o'clock picnic supper, and dancing at the Fairview Hotel. Wow! What, no one had to work on Friday!?

This event was such a success that the members all agreed to do it again the next month! This is a picture of the first trophy ever presented to a winner on our golf course. (Not sure if it was given at the opening of the course or at the next tournament)

This trophy was called the Denniston Cup which was named for the first President of the Rochester Golf Club, A. L. (Arthur Leroy) Denniston. A.L Denniston worked for the Rochester Bridge Company and is the grandfather of Marianne Christenson. Marianne is still a member of our lodge and helps us in the Pro Shop. Thank you, Marianne!
