For the 2012-2013 year the Indiana Elks Association (at their recent State Convention) in Indianapolis gave \$130,000 to each University. To date, the Indiana Elks Association has given over \$8,000,000. The funds come from different fundraisers the lodges have during the year as well as funds that we receive from the Elks National Foundation. For every \$1.00 donated to the Elks National Foundation, Indiana will receive over \$2.00 back to help fund Cancer Research, Hoop Shoot, State Scholarships as well as many other activities that are done in the state. The Indiana Elks Association also awarded 32 - \$1000 state scholarships this year; one of which was Anna Meyer from Rochester Elks #2120.
