## **RULES FOR \$1000 MONTHLY DRAWING**

1. Must be a paid up member of Rochester Lodge #2120
2. Cost is \$20 per person
3. Only 50 spots (numbers) open
4. Must be paid up by third (3) Thursday. If you have not paid by the end of the third Thursday, the next person on the waiting list gets your spot.
