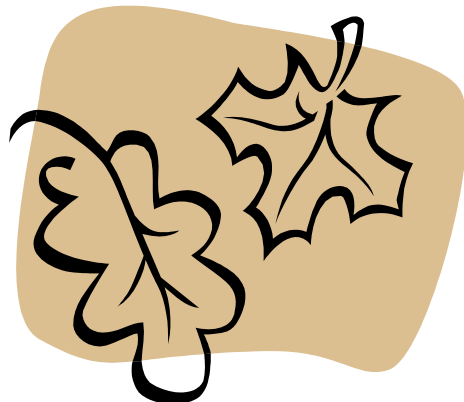
Because of the lack of people eating at the lodge we will be serving food on Friday's only!! Come out and join us for some good fellowship among the members and their guests!
