The recent higher lake level caused by all the rain we have had, coupled with the windy conditions have caused a considerable amount of erosion along our shore. We have been in touch with the DNR, applied for a permit and will soon have the OK to do something about this problem. We are going to put in glacial stone (field stone) along the shore (somewhere in the vicinity of the old shoreline) and then backfill with more stone, sloping it up the bank, hopefully preventing further erosion. All within guidelines the DNR talked with us about. As you can imagine this is an unforeseeable large expense for the Elks. We are in the preliminary planning stages of fundraisers to "Shore up the Shore". All of you are encouraged to help us in this rather large undertaking. Your input would be greatly appreciated, if you have ideas of what kind of fundraisers we could have. Some of our ideas in the planning stages include: a monthly sausage and pancake breakfast (Saturday morning, once a month), a flea market/bake sale, a fish and fries meal, and a golf tournament. We are open to any and all ideas. Step up, help us out, it's your Elks. Help us to "Shore up the Shore".

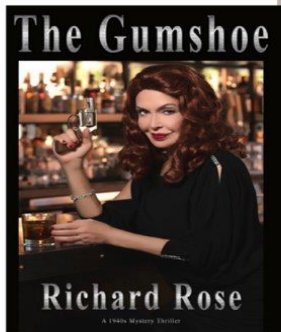
